Ignatian Service Program Update 2020-2021

Coronavirus has created a time of uncertainty, fear, isolation, and illness.

But our faith teaches us that there is light in the darkness. As the Jesuit and broader Catholic network responds in unique ways with love, compassion, and new means of building community, our service program will continue to adjust to our new reality.

As communicated last spring, the requirements for service commitments have changed from a focus on "direct service" outside of the school day, to education and advocacy directly in Ignatian Formation class. We have been working with other Jesuit schools all over the country to come up with collaborative ways to serve our respective communities. Based on the Universal Apostolic Preferences, all students will complete service modules through Ignatian Formation over the course of the year.
