Objective of Health & Safety Plan

- Learn about your responsibilities regarding student wellness check (COVID-19) and reporting to Bellarmino.
- Required use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as face coverings, and processes and procedures for hand washing, disinfecting, and sanitizing our facilities.
 - Health and temperature screening processes for students - *No longer required but highly recommended before arriving on campus*
 - Changes to BPS operating protocols.
 - Entry to campus, classroom layout, and physical distancing at work.

Communication & Training

- All employees, students, and parents are encouraged to review the Health and Safety plan prior to arriving on campus.
- Information and updates can be found in our parent e-news
- Review our website - COVID-19 landing page.
- Campus-wide posters, stickers, and signs will provide reminders.

Health Screening Guidelines

Guidelines for health checks to enter campus

- Parents are asked to assess student wellness before sending student(s) to campus.
- If student(s) is/are experiencing a fever or one or more COVID symptoms please keep the student home.
- Students are encouraged to email teachers to inform them of their absence. Students will be directed to our Learning Management System for access to curriculum and instruction.
- Extended absences and potential accommodations will be reviewed by our Vice Principal of Curriculum and Instruction.

Social Distancing

- Maintain 6-ft separation, where possible, while eating/drinking (during lunch).
- Maintain 3-ft separation between students while in the classroom with other protective measures taken.
- Limit “**close contacts**”.

Classroom Procedure for Students

- Bring your own water.
- Use your own supplies.
- Use your own technology.
- Lab supplies are “single-use”
- Turn toward group members, do not move desks.
- Strict seating charts.
- Keep your space clean.

Face Coverings

- Face masks that cover the nose and mouth are required.
- If you are in a private office with the door closed, or outdoors greater than 6 feet away from someone else while eating, then you may remove your face covering.
- Bring **two face masks** to work each day along with an individually labeled plastic zip lock bag, in case one face mask becomes dirty or soiled during the day.
- Disposable face masks will be provided when needed. These will be located in Bellarmine Hall, the main office.

If Exposed to COVID-19

- Immediately notify Bellarmine, call the attendance line.
- Dean of Students, Cari Harrison and/or Principal, Cindy Davis will contact you.
- Vaccinated individuals will be required to quarantine until they are fever-free for 24 hours.
- Unvaccinated individuals will be required to quarantine for 14 days following exposure.

Student(s) Sick with Potential COVID

- Stay home
- Call your doctor
- If your doctor recommends it, get tested
- Stay Isolated
- Monitor Your Symptoms
- Contact Bellarmine - Attendance office
- Expect follow-up from Ms. Harrison/Ms. Davis

Return to Campus after COVID-19 Test or Symptoms

- If an employee or student has been diagnosed with COVID-19, they may return to the BPS campus when all 3 criteria are met:
 - At least **1 day** (24 hours) have passed since recovery (no fever 100° F without the use of fever-reducing medications); and
 - **AND** you have **improved in respiratory symptoms** (cough, shortness of breath, etc); and
 - **AND** at least **10 days have passed since symptoms first occurred**

Personal & Professional Travel

- Domestic travel is no longer restricted. However, unvaccinated individuals are required to quarantine for 14 days following travel outside of Washington State.
- International Travel During COVID-19
- International travel depends on location, at this time

Sanitizing and Disinfecting Protocols

- Increased sanitizing of “high-touch” surfaces and restrooms throughout the day.
- Nightly deep cleaning and disinfecting
- Interior doors are propped open whenever possible to eliminate touching of door handles.
- All chemicals used in this process are EPA registered products suitable for killing SARS-CoV-2 and other common pathogens.
- Classroom supplies provide additional surface cleaning options.
- Hand Sanitizing
 - Available by most doorways.
 - The foam stays wet longer.

- Manual pumps are more reliable than battery-operated units.
- **Community Events**
 - **Outdoor Activities**
 - Masks are not required but individuals are encouraged to gather by family
 - Masks will be required for all school events such as Mass or an assembly outside due to physical distancing and capacity limitations.
 - **Indoor Activities**
 - Masks are required while indoors regardless of the activity
 - Physical distancing will be expected
