


Bellarmino Preparatory Summer School 2012



Monday, June 25th – Friday, July 27th



Credit

Academic credit is offered, either .25 or .5 credits depending on the class. English I/II Credit Retrieval, English Review for English I, and New Start classes use Bellarmino's grading scale, while Algebra Review uses a Pass/Fail scale, with the expectation that work must be consistently above 66%.

Credit will be denied if a student misses more than three (3) class periods; however, the student would still be eligible for a non-credit Audit (and not applied to the student's overall GPA). Please note that students enrolled in English I/II Credit Retrieval may not miss more than one (1) class period without the prior approval of the Summer School Principal.

A \$100.00 tuition payment must be made with this registration and the balance must be paid by the first day of class. Students who fail to pay the tuition by the end of the summer session will have their grades held and will not receive credit.

A \$35.00 non-refundable registration fee is included in the tuition payment. No tuition refunds will be made after the first day of classes.

Course Request and Registration

Classes meet Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays to accommodate the blended instruction format. Students are expected to complete their Wednesday home-study per teacher's instruction.

Course Selections

English

English I/II Credit Retrieval

(8:00-1:00)

This five-hour course is for current Bellarmine students who did not pass a semester of either English I or English II. This credit retrieval course provides groundwork in composition and literature. (.5 credit)

English Review for English I

(8:00-10:00 or 10:15-12:15)

Designed for students who need and would benefit from a review of grammar, composition, reading comprehension, and the basic rules of English, prior to enrollment in College Prep English I. Placement for the 2012-2013 school year is dependent upon the teacher recommendation and summer school performance. (.25 credit)

English Review for English I

(8:00-10:00) AND

New Start Tutorial

(10:15-11:15)

In addition to English Review for English I (.25 credit), New Start Tutorial is a required course for students enrolled in Bellarmine's New Start program. This one-hour course covers organizational, study skills, note-taking and test-taking strategies, as well as teaching skills to help students "survive" in high school. Students are pre-selected for this course and attendance is mandatory. (No credit)

Math

Algebra Review

(8:00-10:00)

This class is designed to assist students who will be taking Geometry in the fall semester and is open to entering 9th grade students who wish a review before taking Geometry or Advanced Algebra. Topics include: linear equations, rational expressions, the real number system, exponents, quadratic equations, and the quadratic formula. (.25 credit)

Summer School Guidelines

Bellarmino's summer school uses a blended instruction format. A blended learning approach combines face to face classroom methods with computer-mediated activities to form an integrated instructional approach. Classes meet Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesday's instruction from home will be supported through our Moodle program. Enrolled students will have access to the Moodle resource and are expected to complete on-line assignments on time.

Attendance is expected for all classes. Medical appointments should be scheduled after school hours. Family vacations should be scheduled around summer school dates. Students who miss more than three days will not receive credit; credit retrieval students may miss no more than one day. Prior approval of absences must be presented to the Summer School Principal.

Students must be in their assigned room when class begins. Because there are no facilities

available during the summer where students may stay following classes, it is expected that students will leave campus upon the completion of their class(es). Please arrange transportation with these requirements in mind.

Dress code for summer school will be the same as that of the regular school year. As always, modesty should prevail. Please refer to the Bellarmine Handbook available at www.bellarmino.org.

Final grade reports will be mailed home by August 1st, 2012.

Special Notes

Class size is limited. Registration will be accepted in order of date received.

Minimum enrollment is required for each class to be held. Session assignments may be altered to accommodate class size. All fees are refunded if a class is canceled.

Financial aid must be requested in writing through the Summer School Program (not the Financial Aid or Business Office). Availability of funds is not guaranteed.
